The postcode is widely used by healthcare providers and their suppliers. Within the NHS the postcode is used to identify those purchasing healthcare on behalf of individual patients and for research and analysis. The postcode comprises up to seven characters. The first two divide the country into 124 areas (shown below); subsequent characters identify an address to an individual property or section of street.
